You want to enter the EAST PARKING LOT. We will identify this entrance with signs. Once there, we have two unloading lanes available for your use. We will have a variety of rolling carts to aide you in transporting your gear to the cafeteria where it is expected that we will hold the entire event unless we grow too big. Please clear the loading lanes as soon as possible. If the east lot fills, there is parking in the rear. Check-in at the tech inspection desk in the main lobby. Please let us know that you are here so we can assign you an ambassador to get you to your pit area and give you a tour.
